

NET Stimulators Licensed for Import in South Africa

MT. LAUREL, New Jersey – April 22, 2009 – NET Device Corp, a leading developer of medical devices for the treatment of drug addiction, announced today that its **NET Model 804** and **NET Model 901** have been licensed for import in South Africa.

Both medical devices deliver transcranial electrostimulation, known as NeuroElectric Therapy (NET™), to treat persons addicted to nicotine, alcohol, cocaine, heroin, methadone, methamphetamines and other drugs and drug combinations. Additionally, the next generation NET Model 901 enables download of personalized treatment protocols, based on the patient's specific poly-drug profile, direct to the device from NET Device Corp's secure website.

NET medical devices non-invasively effect neuromodulation using low levels of alternating current to re-establish natural levels of brain neurotransmitters which have been disrupted through chronic drug misuse. Combinations of electrical waveforms are tailored to the individual's poly-substance use profile, to achieve rapid drug detoxification without the need for substitute pharmacology. Furthermore, re-stimulation of normal production of neurotransmitters substantially removes long-term cravings, enabling addicts to proceed more easily through rehabilitation.

Studies have shown that combining NET with residential rehabilitation produces drug-free behaviour in 80% of subjects at greater than 1 year from treatment. In a double-blind, randomized, placebo-controlled study, in which NET was used to treat opiate and cocaine in-patient addicts, a "comfortable detoxification and substantial improvement" was achieved.

"We are very pleased to be able to market our NET medical devices in South Africa", said Joe Winston, CEO of NET Device Corp. "This is an important opportunity to extend the benefits of NeuroElectric Therapy beyond Europe, where the devices are CE-marked and already yielding excellent therapeutic results."

Licensing of NET Model 804 and NET Model 901 by the South African Department of Health permits the commercial importation of both devices in South Africa.
